### The 12 Who Turned The World Upside Down Part 10 – JUDAS Iscariot: The Tragedy of Fake Faith

#### **Matthew 27:1-5**

Early in the morning, all the chief priests and the elders of the people came to the decision to put Jesus to death. **2** So they bound him, led him away and handed him over to Pilate the governor. **3** When Judas, who had betrayed him, saw that Jesus was condemned, he was seized with remorse and returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and the elders. **4** “I have sinned,” he said, “for I have betrayed innocent blood.” “What is that to us?” they replied. “That’s your responsibility.” **5** So Judas threw the money into the temple and left. Then he went away and hanged himself.
