## One of My All Time Favorite Quotes

- Irenaeus: "The glory of God is a man fully alive."
- John Eldridge on Irenaeus' quote: "Hope unbidden arose at the thought that God's intentions towards me might be better than I'd thought. His happiness and my happiness are tied together? My coming fully alive is what He's committed to? That's the offer of Christianity? Wow! I mean, it would make no small difference if we knew – and I mean *really* knew – that down-deep-in-your-toes kind of knowing that no one and nothing can talk you out of – if we *knew* that our lives and God's glory were bound together. Things would start looking up. It would feel promising...the offer is life. Make no mistake about that. So then...where *is* that life? Why is it so rare?"

## How to Live the "Fully Alive" Life

### 1. We glorify God when we are fully alive \_\_\_\_\_

- **John 10:10** – *The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.*
- **John 17:3** – *Now this is eternal life: that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom You have sent.*
- **Psalm 63:1-3** – *O God, You are my God; earnestly I seek You; my soul thirsts for You; my flesh faints for You, as in a dry and weary land where there is no water. So I have looked upon You in the sanctuary, beholding Your power and glory. Because Your steadfast love is better than life, my lips will praise You.*
- **Psalm 42:1** – *As the deer pants for flowing streams, so pants my soul for You, O God.*
- **Psalm 27:4** – *One thing have I asked of the Lord, that will I seek after: that I may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of my life, to gaze upon the beauty of the Lord and to inquire in His temple.*

- John Piper: "God is most glorified in us when we are most satisfied in Him."
- **Application #1** – With God's help and power, I want to seek to be fully alive in Him by...
  - Inviting Jesus Christ into my life, receiving His forgiveness of my sins, receiving His free gift of eternal life, and following Him.
  - Cultivating my personal relationship with God by spending daily time with Him in His Word and talking to Him in prayer.
  - Frequently stopping to enjoy God's creation in nature and in other people.
  - Frequently stopping to enjoy God in the moment – to live in the present with God – enjoying God.
  - Soaking in God's Presence during the Thirst Revival Services March 29 thru April 1 at Grace Fellowship.

### 2. We glorify God when we are living fully in the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ that He has given to us

- **1 Peter 4:10-11** – *Each one should use whatever gift he has received to serve others, faithfully administering God's grace in its various forms. If anyone speaks, he should do it as one speaking the very words of God. If anyone serves, he should do it with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen.*

- The glory of God is a man or woman who believes in God even when God seems obscured by the clouds of life.
- Application #3 – Today, I make my faith declarations, and I choose to glorify God with my life in good times and in bad times:
  - I believe in the sun even when it’s not shining.
  - I believe in love even when I don’t feel it.
  - I believe in God even when He is silent.

### 3. We glorify God when we believe in Him even when we cannot Him

- *Psalm 19:1-6*
- God’s creation is continually speaking this message: “God is glorious! God is King! God created all of this!”
- The specific example of Verses 4-6 is the sun:
  - Like a bridegroom coming out of his wedding chamber, the sun is rejoicing, satisfied, and declaring “Wow!”
  - The sun is powerful! So powerful that you cannot look at it (in this life). The sun is a picture of God’s glory. It is powerful. Evident to all. Cannot be gazed upon (in this life). Helpful and essential to life (temperature, plant growth, Vitamin D).
  - The sun cannot be ignored. God’s glory cannot be ignored.
  - There are some days that we cannot see the sun, but it is still there – even when obscured by the clouds. And (even when hidden by the clouds) it is still performing its life-giving functions of temperature, etc.
  - Sometimes it seems like God is not there – obscured by pain and problems and evil and the world and me and depression. But God is still there... sustaining our very lives.
- Anonymous inscription on prison wall at Auschwitz concentration camp for Jews during World War II:

I believe in the sun even when it’s not shining.  
I believe in love even when I don’t feel it.  
I believe in God even when He is silent.

- I have had times in my life when God has been so real...
- I have had times in my life when God has been obscured...
- Irenaeus: “The glory of God is a man fully alive.”
