

## **“Value All People”**

Romans 12:16 – (NIV) “Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud, but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.”

(ESV) “Live in harmony with one another. Do not be haughty but associate with the lowly. Never be wise in your own sight.”

(NLT) “Live in harmony with each other. Don’t be too proud to enjoy the company of ordinary people. And don’t think you know it all.”

Ephesians 4:4-6 – “There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.”

**Don’t be proud or haughty.**

**Associate with those who are considered lowly.**

James 2:1-4 - My brothers and sisters, believers in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ must not show favoritism. Suppose a man comes into your meeting wearing a gold ring and fine clothes, and a poor man in filthy old clothes also comes in. If you show special attention to the man wearing fine clothes and say, “Here’s a good seat for you,” but say to the poor man, “You stand there” or “Sit on the floor by my feet,” have you not discriminated among yourselves and become judges with evil thoughts?

**Do not be full of yourself.**

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain deceit. Rather, in humility we value others above ourselves.”
