Psalm 2



There is a Spiritual Battle Going On

“1 Why do the nations rage, And the people plot a vain thing? 2 The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, Against the LORD and against His Anointed, saying,” (v. 1-2)

- Why Do The Heathen Rage? They Are Lost!
- They Declare Their Opposition
- They Work Together In Opposition
- They Plan Action Against The Lord

The Lord Is Sovereign Over All

“3 Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us. 4 He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The LORD shall hold them in derision. 5 Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, And distress them in His deep displeasure:” (v. 3-5)

- The Lord Laughs at Threats
- The Lord’s Wrath Is Against Them

“6 Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion. 7 I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, ‘You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. 8 Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth for Your possession. 9 You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter’s vessel.” (v. 6-9)

- The Lord Declares Victory For His Son

Choose Jesus

“10 Now therefore, be wise, O kings; Be instructed, you judges of the earth. 11 Serve the LORD with fear, And rejoice with trembling. 12 Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.” (v. 10-12)

- Choose to Listen to The Lord
- Choose to Respect The Lord
- Choose to Trust Him With Your Life

What’s the Point?

1. Pray that People Will Believe in God So They Can Trust In Christ.
2. Pray that People Will Accept God’s Sovereignty Over All People & Things.
3. Pray that People Will Get Ready to See Jesus as King

- The Lord’s Wrath Is Against Them

“6 Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion. 7 I will declare the decree: The LORD has said to Me, ‘You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. 8 Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth for Your possession. 9 You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter’s vessel.” (v. 6-9)

- The Lord Declares Victory For His Son

Choose Jesus

“10 Now therefore, be wise, O kings; Be instructed, you judges of the earth. 11 Serve the LORD with fear, And rejoice with trembling. 12 Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.” (v. 10-12)

- Choose to Listen to The Lord
- Choose to Respect The Lord
- Choose to Trust Him With Your Life
