### **Some Doubt The Lord**

"I LORD, how they have increased who trouble me!

<u>Many are they who rise up against me</u>. 2 Many are they who say of me, "<u>There is no help for him in God</u>. Selah" (v. 1-2)

## You Can Depend On Him

"3 But <u>You, O LORD</u>, are a shield for me, My glory and the One who <u>lifts up my head</u>." (v. 3)

- Believe God Protects You
- Believe God <u>Helps</u> You "4 <u>I cried</u> to the LORD with my voice, <u>And He heard me</u> from His holy hill. Selah" (v. 4)
- Believe God <u>Hears</u> You "5 <u>I lay down and slept</u>; I awoke, for <u>the LORD</u> <u>sustained me</u>." (v. 5)
- Believe God <u>Sustains</u> You "6 I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people Who have set themselves against me all around." (v. 6)
- Result: God <u>Removes</u> Your <u>Fear</u>
  "7 <u>Arise, O LORD; Save me, O my God! For You have</u>
  <u>struck</u> all my enemies on the cheekbone; <u>You have broken</u>
  the teeth of the ungodly. 8 <u>Salvation belongs to the LORD</u>.
  <u>Your blessing is upon Your people</u>." (v. 7-8)
- Result: God Brings <u>Victory</u> and <u>Blessing</u>
