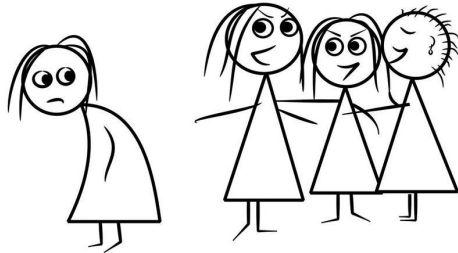

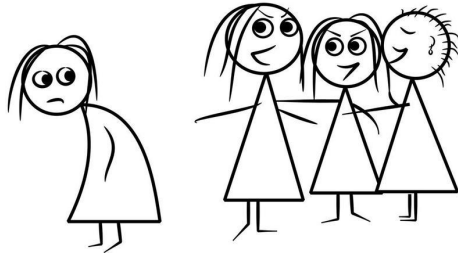

Be A Hypocrite

- We Can’t See Our Own

Be A Brother/Sister

- First, Examine Yourself
- Then, Help Others
