"7 His mouth is full of <u>cursing</u> and <u>deceit</u> and <u>oppression</u>; Under his tongue is trouble and iniquity. 8 <u>He</u> <u>sits in the lurking places of the villages</u>; In the secret places <u>he murders the innocent</u>; His eyes are secretly fixed on the <u>helpless</u>. 9 He <u>lies in wait secretly</u>, as a lion in his den; He lies in wait to catch the <u>poor</u>; He catches the poor when he draws him into his net. 10 So he crouches, he lies low, That <u>the helpless</u> may fall by his strength." (v. 7-10)
