How Did Jesus Get Authority?

- Why Does Jesus Astonish People? His <u>Authority</u> "9 For <u>I also am a man under **authority**</u>, having soldiers <u>under me</u>. And <u>I say to this one</u>, `Go,' and he goes; and to another, `<u>Come</u>,' and he comes; and to my servant, `<u>Do this</u>,' <u>and he does it</u>." (Mt. 8:9)
- Authority = Command, <u>Control</u>, or <u>Power</u> *"8 Now when the multitudes saw it, <u>they marveled and</u> <u>glorified God</u>, <u>who had given such power to men</u>." (Mt. 9:8)*
- Authority Comes From God

• <u>God</u> Gave Jesus <u>ALL</u> Authority

Why Did Jesus <u>Have</u> Authority?

• Jesusø Miracles Pointed People to God

• Jesus <u>Forgave</u> Sins

• Jesus <u>Delegated</u> Power

What Does It Matter?

"27 Then they were all amazed, so that <u>they questioned</u> <u>among themselves</u>, saying, <u>"What is this</u>? What new doctrine is this? For <u>with **authority** He commands even the unclean</u> <u>spirits</u>, and they obey Him</u>." (Mk. 1:27)

• Who Is Jesus? Is He <u>God</u>? Or <u>Not</u>?

"...Father, the hour has come. <u>Glorify Your Son</u>, that Your Son also may glorify You, 2 <u>as You have given Him</u> **authority** over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him. 3 And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent." (Jn. 17:1-3)

• Jesus Has Authority to <u>Give</u> You <u>Life</u>

"12 But <u>as many as received Him</u>, to them He gave the **right** to <u>become children of God</u>, <u>to those who believe in His</u> <u>name</u>: 13 <u>who were born</u>, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but <u>of God</u>." (Jn. 1:12-13)
