- "7 <u>A woman of Samaria came to draw water. Jesus said</u> to her, 'Give Me a drink.' 8 For His disciples had gone away into the city to buy food. 9 Then the woman of Samaria said to Him, 'How is it that You, being a Jew, ask a drink from me, a Samaritan woman?' For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans." (v. 7-9)
- We Must Have Lost Friends

Tell Them About Jesus

"10 Jesus answered and said to her, 'If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, "Give Me a drink," you would have asked Him, and He would have given you living water.' 11 The woman said to Him, 'Sir, You have nothing to draw with, and the well is deep. Where then do You get that living water? 12 Are You greater than our father Jacob, who gave us the well, and drank from it himself, as well as his sons and his livestock?'" (v. 10-12)

• Look For An Opportunity

"13 Jesus answered and said to her, 'Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again, 14 but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life.' 15 The woman said to Him, 'Sir, give me this water, that I may not thirst, nor come here to draw.'" (v. 13-15)

• Connect With Their Need

"16 Jesus said to her, 'Go, call your husband, and come here.' 17 The woman answered and said, 'I have no husband.' Jesus said to her, 'You have well said, "I have no husband," 18 for you have had five husbands, and the one whom you now have is not your husband; in that you spoke truly.' " (v. 16-18)

• Encourage Them to Repent

"19 The woman said to Him, 'Sir, I perceive that You are a prophet'...25 The woman said to Him, 'I know that Messiah is coming' (who is called Christ). 'When He comes, He will tell us all things.' 26 Jesus said to her, 'I who speak to you am He.' " (v. 19, 25-26)

- Help Them <u>Trust</u> In <u>Jesus</u>
- "39 And many of the Samaritans of that city believed in <u>Him</u> because of the word of the woman who testified, 'He told me all that I ever did.' " (v. 39)
- Jesus Will <u>Change</u> Their <u>Life</u>
