Who wrote the book (Author)?

John Mark

What does he say about himself?

He was not one of the 12 disciples, but he accompanied Paul on his first missionary journey

Who did he write to (Audience)?

The Christians at Rome

What does he say about them?

Who did he write about to them? (Others)

Jesus, the 12 disciples, Pilate, the Jewish religious leaders

What does he say about them?

When did he write the book? (Time, or Date)

Between AD 55 and 65

When did the book take place? (Time, or Date)

During Jesus' earthly lifetime, from 4BC - 30 AD

Where did he write the book?

Rome

Where did the book take place (Location)?

Capernaum, Nazareth, Caesarea Philippi, Jericho, Bethany, Mount of Olives, Jerusalem, Golgotha

Why did the writer write the book (Purpose)?

To present the person, work, and teachings of Jesus
