Savor the taste of our previous brew



Since everything in the Bible leads into and prepares the way for what comes after it, refresh yesterday's Brew to let the previous passage get you ready for today's verses. Though you should have already explored the passage, personally with Jesus, here is the heart of what we saw, together.

<u>In the previous passage</u>, verses 11-14, the LORD expands the inventory of gifts He gave to His covenant bride.

Pay careful attention to *every* item as you follow today's devotional in your study Bible. We have already grouped them by <u>colors</u> in "Today's Text," so you can follow the writer's flow of thought for yourself. Capture and grasp what he is trying to tell you with matching color pencils to draw lines connecting items to others in the same color-family, and a black pencil to cross-link <u>items</u> from different color-families that still have something to do with one another. Use circles, boxes, triangles, etc. to identify topics and themes (triangles, for instance, might represent the Trinity). Also mark with asterisks, etc., the ones you need to look up later for more information or greater details.

## **TODAY'S TEXT**

### **New Living Translation**

- <sup>15</sup> "But you thought your fame and beauty were your own. So, you gave yourself as a prostitute to every man who came along. Your beauty was theirs for the asking.
- <sup>16</sup> You used the lovely things I gave you to make shrines for idols, where you played the prostitute. Unbelievable! How could such a thing ever happen?
- <sup>17</sup> You took the very jewels and gold and silver ornaments I had given you and made statues of men and worshiped them. This is adultery against me!
- <sup>18</sup> You used the beautifully embroidered clothes I gave you to dress your idols. Then you used my special oil and my incense to worship them.
- 19 Imagine it! You set before them as a sacrifice the choice flour, olive oil, and honey I had given you, says the Sovereign LORD.
- <sup>20</sup> "Then you took your sons and daughters—the children you had borne to me—and sacrificed them to your gods. Was your prostitution not enough?
- <sup>21</sup> Must you also slaughter my children by sacrificing them to idols?
- <sup>22</sup> In all your years of adultery and detestable sin, you have not once remembered the days long ago when you lay naked in a field, kicking about in your own blood.

#### THE EXPANDED BIBLE

- <sup>15</sup> "'But you trusted in your beauty. You used your fame to become a prostitute. You ·had sexual relations with [lavished sexual favors on] anyone who passed by.
- <sup>16</sup> You took some of your clothes and made your ·places of worship [high places; <u>6:3</u>] ·colorful [decorated; gaudy]. There you carried on your prostitution. ·These things should not happen; they should never occur [*or* You went to him and became his; *or* How could such a thing ever have happened? <sup>c</sup> the Hebrew here is obscure].
- <sup>17</sup>You also took your beautiful jewelry, made from my gold and silver I had given you, and you made for yourselves male idols so you could be a prostitute with them [2 Kin. 23:7].
- <sup>18</sup>Then you took your ·clothes with beautiful needlework [embroidered clothing] and covered the idols. You gave my oil and incense as an offering to them.
- <sup>19</sup> Also, you took the ·bread [food] I gave you, the fine flour, oil, and honey I gave you to eat, and you offered them before the gods as a ·pleasing smell [fragrant incense]. This is what happened, says the Lord God.
- <sup>20</sup> "But your ·sexual sins [acts of prostitution] were not enough for you. You also took your sons and daughters who ·were my children [you bore to me], and you sacrificed them to the idols as food.
- <sup>21</sup> You ·killed [slaughtered] my children and offered them up in fire to the idols [<u>Lev. 18:21; 20:2; Deut. 12:31; 18:10; 2 Kin. 16:3; 21:6; 23:10; Jer. 32:35</u>].
- <sup>22</sup> While you did all your ·hateful [detestable; abominable] acts and ·sexual sins [prostitution], you did not remember ·when you were young [Lthe days of your youth], when you were naked and had no clothes and were ·left [Lkicking about] in your blood.

## **THE SCRIPTURES 1998/2009**

- <sup>15</sup> But you trusted in your own loveliness, and whored because of your name, and poured out your whorings on everyone passing by who would have it.
- <sup>16</sup> And you took some of your garments and made multi-coloured high places for yourself, and whored on them which should not have come about, nor shall it be.
- <sup>17</sup> And you took your splendid adornments, of My gold and My silver that I gave you, and made for yourself images of a male and whored with them.
- <sup>18</sup> And you took your embroidered garments and covered them, and you set My oil and My incense before them.
- <sup>19</sup> And My food which I gave you, fine flour and oil and honey which I fed you, you set it before them as sweet incense and so it was," declares the Master יהוה.
- <sup>20</sup> And you took your sons and your daughters, whom you bore to Me, and these you slaughtered as food to them. Were your whorings a small matter,
- <sup>21</sup> that you have slain My children and gave them up to them by causing them to pass through the fire?
- <sup>22</sup> And in all your abominations and whorings you did not remember the days of your youth, when you were naked and bare, trampled down in your blood."

## THE NET BIBLE

- <sup>15</sup> But you trusted in your beauty and capitalized on your fame by becoming a prostitute. You offered your sexual favors to every man who passed by so that your beauty<sup>12</sup> became his.
- <sup>16</sup> You took some of your clothing and made for yourself decorated high places; you engaged in prostitution on them. You went to him to become his.<sup>13</sup>
- <sup>17</sup> You also took your beautiful jewelry, made of my gold and my silver I had given to you, and made for yourself male images and engaged in prostitution<sup>14</sup> with them.
- <sup>18</sup> You took your embroidered clothing and used it to cover them; you offered my olive oil and my incense to them.
- <sup>19</sup> As for my food that I gave you–the fine flour, olive oil, and honey I fed you–you placed it before them as a soothing aroma. That is exactly what happened, declares the sovereign LORD.
- <sup>20</sup> "You took your sons and your daughters whom you bore to me and you sacrificed them<sup>15</sup> as food for the idols to eat. As if your prostitution not enough,
- <sup>21</sup> you slaughtered my children and sacrificed them to the idols. <sup>16</sup>

And with all your abominable practices and prostitution you did not remember the days of your youth when you were naked and bare, kicking around in your blood.
