## Savor the taste of our previous brew



Since everything in the Bible leads into and prepares the way for what comes after it, refresh yesterday's Brew to let the previous passage get you ready for today's verses. Though you should have already explored the passage, personally with Jesus, here is the heart of what we saw, together.

In the previous passage, verses $42-45$, the LORD sums up how He will pay back His wife for her unfaithfulness and explains her tendency toward evil.

After that finally
My, the Eternal Unstoppable One's hostility aimed at I/J/R/E

## Serving The Brew

## Let us pour you a fresh cup, ground verse-by-verse from today's passage

In today's passage, verses 46-52, compares Israel's abominations with those of her sister cities, Samaria and Sodom because she is already bearing the disgrace. So please open your Bibles to Ezekiel Chapter 16, and let me pour you a hot Cuppajesus from today's brew, starting with v. 46.

Pay careful attention to every item as you follow today's devotional in your study Bible. We have already grouped them by colors under Today's Text, so you can follow the writer's flow of thought for yourself. Capture what he is trying to tell you. Use matching color pencils to draw lines connecting items to others in the same color family. A black pen can cross-link things from different color-families that still have something to do with one another. Utilize circles, boxes, triangles, etc. to identify topics and themes (triangles, for instance, might represent the Trinity). Also, mark the ones you need to look up later for more information or details with asterisks, etc.

## Today's Text

## New Living Translation

${ }^{46}$ "Your older sister was Samaria, who lived with her daughters in the north. Your younger sister was Sodom, who lived with her daughters in the south.

## The Expanded Bible

${ }^{46}$ Your older sister is Samaria, who lived north of you with her daughters; your younger sister is Sodom, who lived south of you with her daughters [Gen. 19; ${ }^{\text {º }}$ Sodom is a symbol of evil in Scripture; Deut. 29:23; 32:32; Is. 1:9-10; 3:9; Jer. 23:14; Lam. 4:6; Matt. 10:15; 11:23-24; Jude 7].
${ }^{47}$ You not only •followed [walked in] their ways and did the •hateful [detestable; abominable] things they did, but you were soon worse [more corrupt/depraved] than they were in all your ways.
${ }^{48}$ As surely as I live, says the Lord GoD, your sister Sodom and her daughters never did what you and your daughters have done.
49 "'This was the •sin [iniquity; guilt] of your sister Sodom: She and her daughters were proud and had plenty of food and lived in great comfort [secure ease], but she did not •help ['strengthen the hand off the poor and needy.
${ }^{50}$ So Sodom and her daughters were • proud [haughty] and did •things I hate [detestable/abominable things] in front of me. So I -got rid of [removed] them when I saw what they did.
${ }^{51}$ Also, Samaria [ ${ }^{\text {c }}$ the northern kingdom] did not do half the sins you do; you have done more •hateful [detestable; abominable] things than they did. So you make your sisters look good [appear righteous] because of all the •hateful [detestable; abominable] things you have done.
${ }^{52}$ You will •suffer [bear your] disgrace, because you have • provided an excuse ['interceded with your sins] for your sisters. They -are better [appear more righteous] than you are. Your sins were even more •terrible [vile; abominable] than theirs. Feel ashamed and suffer disgrace, because you made your sisters look good [appear righteous].

## The Scriptures 1998/2009

${ }^{46}$ And your elder sister is Shomeron, she and her daughters, who is dwelling to the north of you. And your younger sister, who is dwelling to the south of you, is Sedom and her daughters.
${ }^{47}$ And have you not walked in their ways and did according to their abominations? But in all your ways you soon became more corrupt than they.
${ }^{48}$ As I live," declares the Master יהוה, "neither your sister Sedom nor her daughters have done as you and your daughters have done."
${ }^{49}$ See, this was the crookedness of your sister Sedom: She and her daughter had pride, sufficiency of bread, and unconcerned ease. And she did not help the poor and needy.
${ }^{50}$ And they were haughty and did abomination before Me, and I took them away when I saw it.

## Believe it or not

Samaria, the capital of the Northern Kingdom of Israel never carried out even $50 \%$ of your attempts to please me that fell short.
You, I/J/R/E performed much worse nauseating violations of God's standards
compared to those Samaria and Sodom managed at any time.
Samaria and Sodom give the impression they are right with Me
side by side with you.
You should feel sorry!
Your, I/J/R/E attempts to please me that fell short are nauseating to the point
You, I/J/R/E cause Samaria and Sodom
to give the impression they are right with Me
And more than that, that they have high moral standards.
