1. Matt. 14:15-21 The Feeding of the 500.
 - A. “When it was evening”
 1. “a desert place”
 2. “the time is now past”
 3. “send them away”
 - B. But Jesus said, “they need not depart.” – The miracle.

2. Mk. 5:22-24, 35-36, 38-42 Jairus’ Daughter.
 - A. Jairus’ daughter was sick. Jesus went to heal her.
 - B. Jesus’ going was interrupted by someone else needing a miracle.
 - C. The daughter died before Jesus could get there.
 1. Jesus’ arrival – The miracle.

3. Luke 7:12-15 The Miracle of the Widow’s Son.
 - A. The widow was left with nothing and no one.
 - B. Jesus had compassion on her. see Heb. 4:15
 - C. The miracle

4. Jn. 11:1, 3, 6, 20-21, 32, 27, 29, 41, 43-44 The Raising of Lazarus.
 - A. Upon hearing of Lazarus’ sickness, Jesus waited two days before going.
 - B. Martha said, “if thou hadst been here, my brother had not died”
 - C. Lazarus had been dead 4 days and was already sealed away in the tomb.
 - D. The miracle.
