Understanding the Doctrine of Predestination

- 1. Romans 8:28-29; Eph. 1:4-5, 11; Rev. 17:8
 - A. What is Predestination?
 - B. Where it came from?

C. Who believes it today?

Note! The word "Predestination" is found only 4 times in the Bible: twice in Romans and twice in Ephesians.

- 2. The misunderstanding in this doctrine is that it is <u>individuals</u> who are predestined in these scriptures. In reality it is <u>the church collectively</u> that is in reference here.
- 3. This is confirmed by the multiple use of <u>plural</u> pronouns in these verses. See <u>Romans 8:28-39</u>. Compare with <u>Romans 9:1-3</u> also see <u>Ephesians 1:3-12</u> and compare with <u>Ephesians 3:2-5</u>.
- 4. Scriptures that prove it is <u>God's will that all men be saved</u>. (These verses refute the Calvinistic doctrine that we're predetermined to be saved or lost from birth.) <u>1 Timothy 2:4</u>, <u>II Peter 3:9</u>, <u>Acts 17:25</u>, <u>27</u>, <u>30</u>, <u>Matthew 11:28</u>, <u>John 3:15-18</u>.
- 5. Scriptures that prove that <u>anyone can be lost</u>, even individuals who are presently saved. (These verses refute the doctrine of eternal security...once saved always saved, a milder form of the doctrine of predestination.) <u>II Peter 2:20-22</u>, <u>Romans 11:21-22</u>, <u>1 Corinthians 9:27</u>, <u>Revelation 2:4-5</u>, <u>Revelation 2:14-16</u>, <u>Revelation 3:15-16</u>.
- 6. Understanding "The Book of Life from the Foundation of the World". Revelation 17:8, this verse refers to The Book of Life and not to the individual's name that is from the foundation of the world. See Revelation 3:5, Ex. 32:32-33
