- 1. Romans 9:10-13 "Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated".
 - A. <u>Genesis 25:23</u> this verse refers to <u>the individuals</u> here and implies that they would be different nations.
 - B. Romans 9:13 is quoted from Malachi 1:1-3 and refers to Jacob (Israel) and Esau, (Edom) as Nations not individuals.
 - 1. "Esau is Edom" Genesis 36:8
 - 2. The land of Edom was "Petra". See photos of Petra.
 - 3. Why God hated Esau/Edom, see Obadiah 1:10-15, 18-19
- 2. Romans 9:17-22 Pharaoh in Moses day:
 - A. <u>Genesis 7:2-4</u> <u>God hardened Pharaoh's heart</u>. <u>Why</u>? To show his power to both the Egyptians and the Israelites. God had already given Pharaoh ample time to do what was right.

 Romans 9:22
 - B. <u>How God uses heathen Kings for his purpose</u>. <u>Ezra 1:1-3</u> and Isaiah 44:28, 45:4
 - 1. How God spoke to Winston Churchill during W.W. II.
 - C. Note: Romans chapters 8 & 9 is all about the sovereignty of God and not predetermined individual salvation.
