 - A. The Northern Kingdom (Israel). Conquered in 721 B.C. by the Assyrians.

- From 606 B.C. until today, Israel has been subject to Gentile powers.
 A. Daniel was shown Israel's future from 606 B.C. until Israel would be restored in the end time.
- 3. Israelites returned to Palestine in 536 B.C. to rebuild the temple and reestablish Israel as a nation.

 - A. His ministry and miracles were evidence of His identity.
 - B. Jesus' rejection and crucifixion.
 - C. Jesus' resurrection and ascension.
 - D. The beginning of the church age.
- 5. The coming of the Roman army and the destruction of Jerusalem and the Temple in 70 A.D.
 - A. Jews were sold into slavery and scattered all over the world.
 - B. Over the years there have been attempts by Jews to reestablish Israel as a nation, a home for the Jewish people. This is called "Zionism."
