1. The blessings of God upon Abraham went to Isaac after Abraham's death. **Gen. 26:12-15**
2. Isaac re-dug the wells. **Gen. 26:18-22, 25, 32**
3. The importance of the wells.
 - A. A source of Life and Blessings.
 - B. A source of Peace. **II Sam. 23:15-17**
 - C. It symbolizes the source of our spiritual life. **Jn. 4:10-14**
4. As with Abraham and Isaac the enemy will try to destroy the spiritual wells in our lives by enticing us to...
 - A. Question the Word of God. **Gen. 3:1-3**
 - B. Loving the world. **I Jn. 2:15-17, II Tim. 4:10**
 - C. Exalt ourselves. **I Tim. 3:6, Prov. 16:18-19**
 - D. Quit praying, fasting, worshiping, and attending church faithfully. **I Thess. 5:17-18, Heb. 10:25**
5. Note: An on-coming generation of believers must sometimes re-dig the Wells of Truth and Salvation and we, as individuals, must do the same.
 - A. The Kings of Judah were sometimes careless in their commitment to God. **II Kg. 15:32, 34-35**
 - B. Compare with Hezekiah **II Kg. 18:1, 3-7**
