

Seven Mountains of Israel and Their Significance

1. Mount Sinai (6,500 ft) – **Exodus 19:10-11, 16, 19 & Exodus 20:1**
 - A. The 10 Commandments were given in **Exodus 20** by God audibly.
 - 1.) The people's response – **Exodus 20:19**
 - 2.) God wanted Israel to understand the power in the word of God.
 - 3.) When the prophecy of Christ's coming was given, the request of Israel was granted – **Deuteronomy 18:15-19**
2. Mount Nebo (11,933 ft)- **Deuteronomy 34:1-5.**
 - A. Moses was a type of the Law. It was completed when grace came by Jesus Christ – **John 1:17 & Luke 16:16**
3. Mount Zion (2,600 ft)
 - A. Represents the grace of God and the church – **Hebrews 12:18-19, 21-24, 28**
4. Mount Mariah – Temple Mount (2,600ft)
 - A. Represents our obedience – **Genesis 22:1-2 & Hebrews 13:17**
 - B. Represents our worship – **Psalms 117 & Psalms 150**
5. Mount Carmel (1,750 ft)
 - A. Represents resisting the enemy – **I Kings 18:19, 30, 37-38**
6. Mount Herman (9,200 ft)
 - A. Represents God's reassurance – **Mark 9:2-4** – Jesus' transfiguration
7. Mount of Olives (2,600 ft)
 - A. Jesus' ascension and promise of His return – **Acts 1:8-11**
