The GO initiative has forever changed our church and given us a focus on ministries and missions that is making a significant difference in the world around us.

It started in 2016 as I watched thousands of people in Madagascar give their life savings to the church for the purpose of evangelizing their country. It so touched my heart that I began to cry and the Lord spoke to me.

The Lord reminded me that the great commission of the church is to GO and be witnesses in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and all the world. (Acts 1:8). The fulfilling of this commission is accomplished through your commitment to GO.

The four categories represented by the four geographical locations reveal our mandate to invest into four areas of ministry: our local community, our national ministries, our individuals in need of assistance, and global missionaries.

Last year our church stepped out in faith and committed to give from hearts of compassion. In an organization of 34,000 churches around the world, Eastwind was in the top 20 churches in 4 categories: Home Missions, Children's Ministries, Ladies Ministries and Global Missions.

In 2021 we were able to launch the Palm Bay Outpouring where we evangelized our local community culminating in a crusade held at the

Bayside High School football stadium. This was accomplished through your giving to GO.

The Winds Conference is impacting our movement and mobilizing an entire generation through the power of God. This conference, sponsored and supported by your giving to GO, launched in the middle of covid last year. In only two years we have been placed in the epic center of God's divine plan for end time revival.

In 2022 we are launching a new ministry to reach the world called Global Harvest in Motion. We will train hundreds of millennials and young adults to reach North America and other countries through crusades.

We begin training in January with Chris Green and Charles Robinette. We will participate in ten crusades in 2022. Five in North America and five overseas. This is just the beginning of a million-soul revival over the next five years.

Your commitment to give sacrificially to GO is the engine behind these ministries. I ask that you prayerfully consider your commitment to give to GO in 2022. God will reward and bless you for your giving.

GO resources help take the gospel to those that cannot come to us. Our Nursing Home/Shut-in Ministry reaches out every month to those that are unable to attend services. Our prison team visits the prisons to bring worship and the word to those that are locked in. Our online presence has grown tremendously, reaching those that cannot be in service with us.



IMPACT COMMUNITIES & NORTH AMERICAN MISSIONS

Metro and rural areas across the USA need churches. It is because of funds received from programs like GO that they can concentrate on building churches in these areas. Not everyone is called to plant churches, but we are commissioned to pray and give to help those that are called.



MOTHER'S MEMORIAL

This Ladies ministry fund supports 11 different causes including Ladies Conference, New Beginnings, Multicultural Ministries, World Network of Prayer, Tupelo Children's Mansion, appliances for missionaries, bible studies and tracts for North American Missionaries and more.



NEW BEGINNINGS ADOPTION

New Beginnings International Children's & Family Services is focused on promoting life and new beginnings for children, birth mothers and families through parenting education and adoption.



LIGHTHOUSE BOY'S RANCH

The Lighthouse Ranch for Boys program is for boys (12-17 yrs. old) who need a stable environment. Many have been victims of abuse, neglect, drugs, and unstable homes. The Lighthouse Ranch is able to provide a consistent, stable and structured place to help these young men grow.



MOVE THE MISSION

Move the Mission funds events and ministries locally and nationally for our students, supplies missionaries with vehicles to help them spread the gospel, supports North American Missionaries, supplies Bible School scholarships and more! Thank you for seeing the need and going beyond the walls of our building.



SAVE OUR CHILDREN

This funds the General Sunday School Division. 50% of funds remain in Florida for projects such as Junior camps, children's crusades, teacher training, and Junior Bible Quizzing and 50% goes to the General Sunday School Division for various children's ministries across North America.

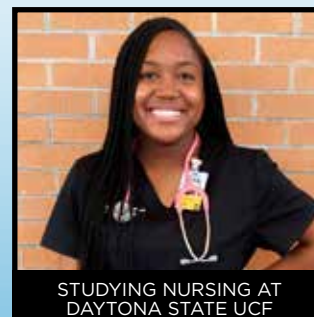

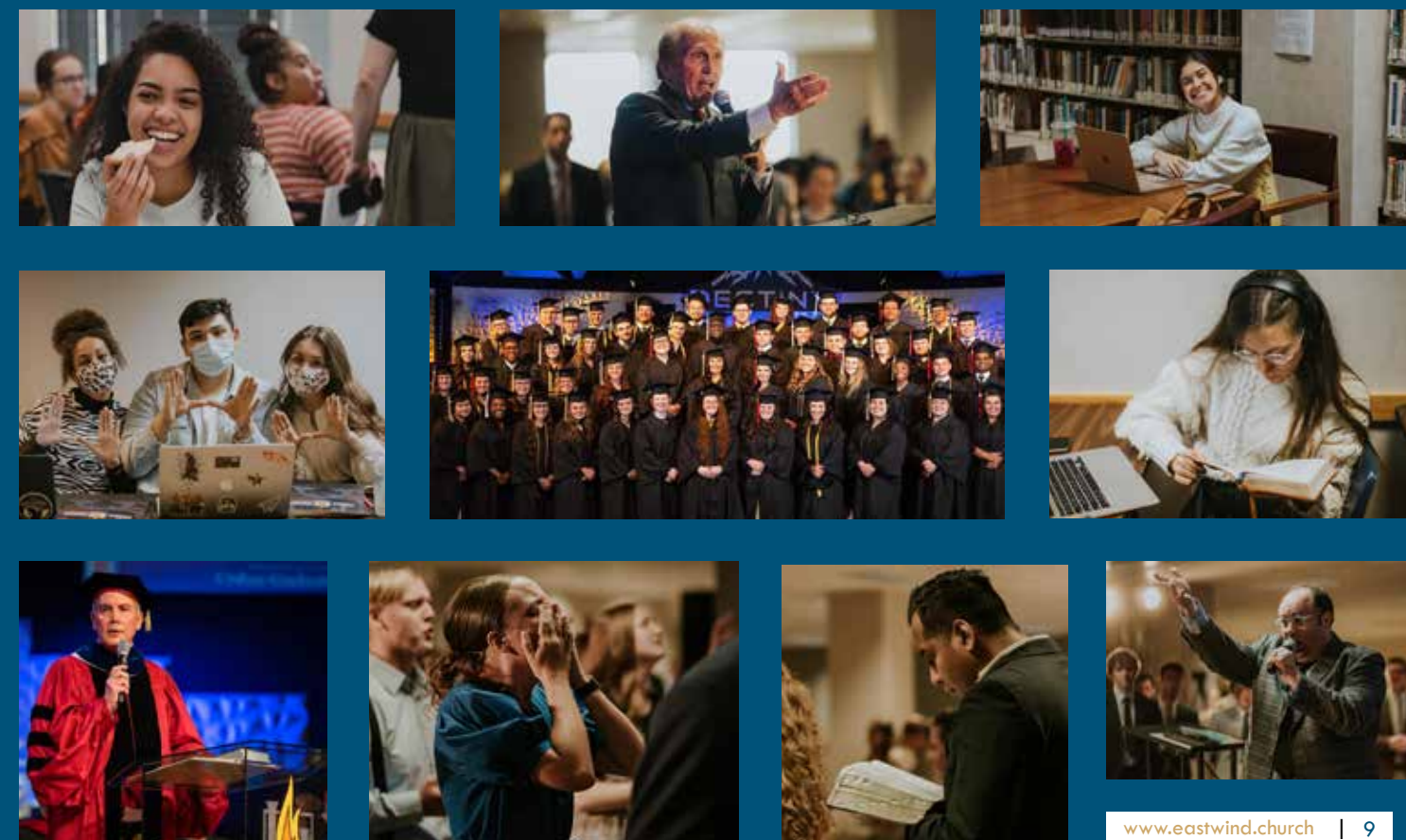

MISSION'S TRIP TO MONTANA



"What's even in Montana?", is a question I've been asked so many times this past year. I've felt a passion to expand my world view and to experience how other cultures live and AYC Montana was the perfect opportunity for me. The Native American culture is a big part of Montana's history. However, today many are homeless and have turned to drugs and alcohol.

AYC Montana was such an impactful experience for me! It was my first mission trip, and I had the opportunity to serve both the city of Cody and the Native American community. While in Cody, we had the opportunity to knock on doors and hand out tracks inviting people to the local church. On that Wednesday night, a lady we invited to church showed up and was healed of her hearing, filled with the Holy Ghost, and was baptized in the name of Jesus Christ. One of the highlights of the trip was serving and ministering during the Wyola camp meeting on the Crow reservation. During Wyola camp meeting we served in many ministries including children's ministry, preparing and serving meals, assisted their media team, and lead praise and worship. On the last day of camp, we went down to the river and was able to participate in 3 baptisms. The biggest takeaway from this trip was seeing how broken the Native American communities are. It opened my eyes to see that there are people living in the same country as me but have a totally different standard of living that almost seems like a third world country. AYC Montana has given me a burden for these communities.

MISSION'S TRIP TO LOS ANGELES



Los Angeles is known for the glamour and glitz. It's a city for dreamers. Its nickname, "La La Land", is fitting, even among the wealthy the city is full of empty people. My Apostolic Youth Corps (AYC) group saw the lost look in the eyes of the city people. We talked with them about hope and prayed on their streets, and in their homes. I remember the first door we knocked on during outreach was a single mother just trying to make it day to day. I remember the peace that entered her home as a group of young people prayed for her and her son. Her hope was restored. The second morning we arrived in Los Angeles, we drove into Downtown LA to serve the people of Skid Row. Roughly 36,000 people live in boxes and tarps, susceptible to danger and diseases daily. I saw tears run down the faces of those that no longer wanted to live that lifestyle, but did not know how to find a way out. Yet, I saw hope restored; that God would make a way for them. I talked with people in the streets. I stopped their busy lives for God's light to shine just for a moment. I heard many say, "This is what we've been looking for," then watched them as they were baptized in the name of Jesus. Hundreds of flyers were handed out to people of many cultures: Hispanic, European, and Deaf are just a few examples. Hope was restored in the hearts of many Los Angelenos that day.

These experiences would not have been possible if AYC was not offered to young people with a hunger to see God do the miraculous. Every year, hundreds of young people choose to commit a week of their summer vacation to give back. More often than not, the students are the ones that come back changed forever. They come back with a hunger for the will of God like never before and with a humility knowing that while we are living comfortable lives, there are neighbors that need God just as much as we do. AYC has forever changed me.

Yes. You will receive the same giving record as in years past. It will include any designated tithes, offerings and paid pledges for the year.

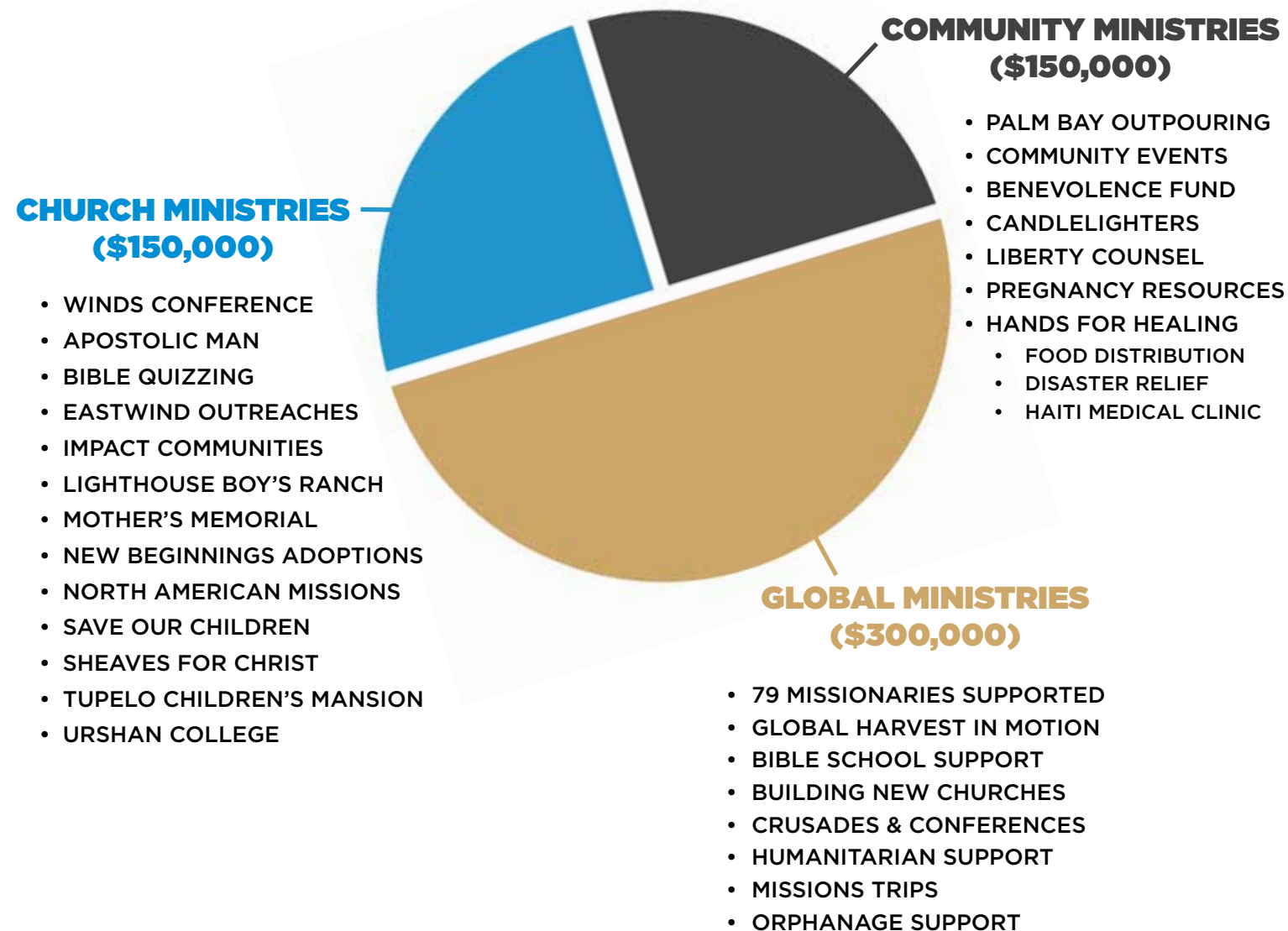
WHAT PAYMENT METHODS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR THIS PLEDGE?

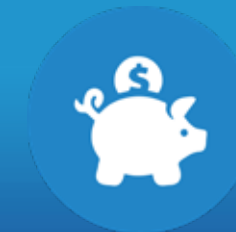
