The Greatest Event in the History of Man

1. He that knew no sin took upon Himself our sins.

II Cor. 5:21; Heb. 4:15; I Pet. 2:21-24 I Jn. 3:5;

Note Mat. 27:46 and Psalms 22:1

2. The resistance to Jesus by the religious leaders of His day.

A. Their accusations.

1. Not keeping the traditions of men such as: “not washing hands” **Mk. 7:1-3, 6-9**

2. Not keeping the sabbath. **John 9:1, 6-7, 13-14, 25**

3. Jesus forgiving sins. **Mk. 2:3-12**

4. Jesus identifying Himself as God.

Jn. 8:56-59; 10:30-31, 37-38; Jn. 12:44-45

B. For such reasons as these they sought to kill Him. Matt. 26:3-4

3. The crucifixion of Christ prophesied in Old Testament

A. As an observant. Isa. 53

B. As a participant. Psalms 22

1. David knew the Messiah that would come would be from himself. **I Chron. 17:4, 10-14, 16-17**
