How We Defeat Satan I Peter 5:8

1. Satan cast out of Heaven.

Isa. 14:12-15; Eph. 28:13-19 Luke 10:18-20.

His great sin was pride and self-glory.

A. Mankind's battle with pride:

Prov. 16:18-19 Prov. 29:23, I Jn. 2:15-16

- B. We overcome pride with humility. I Pet. 5:5-6, Jas. 4:10
 All praise and glory must be to God only.
- 2. God's power to the church: Glorify God with praise.

Jer. 9:23-24; Psa 117:1-2; Heb. 13:15

- A. Early civilizations failed to do this. **Rom. 1:21-25**
- 3. David discovered the power of God through praise and worship.
 - A. Note: The word "praise" is found only once in Genesis and only four times in the Law Books.
 - B. When David was still young, he came to realize that God's protection and advancements in life were based on obedience to God's Word and that God alone was due ALL praise and worship.
 - C. When David became King, he made praise and worship to God a #1 priority. See Psa. 135:1-3; 146:1-2; 147:1; 148:1-5; 149:1, 3; 150:1-6
 - D. This commitment to worship and to praising God came to be called "The Tabernacle of David" **Amos 9:11; Acts 15:16**
 - E. This is how we defeat Satan and live victoriously:
