- 1. The funeral of the Queen of England has many wondering "Is this the end of an era?"
 - A. B.B.C News recently reported:
 - 1. Europe is having the worse drought in 500 years.
 - 2. In Germany the shrinking of the Rhine River is causing less shipping in Eastern and Western Europe potentially causing food shortages.
 - 3. In China there is the beginning of a vast climate change, causing extreme droughts in some places vs. flash floods in others.
 - 4. In Africa (Ethiopia, Kenya, and Somalia) the U.N. warns that a coming famine could cause 22 million deaths.
 - B. The war between Russia and Ukraine continues to pull more nations into its conflict.
 - 1. There is fear that Russia may engage nuclear weapons in this war.
 - 2. Note the number of nuclear warheads in these nations.

 - U.S. 5,428
 - France 290
 - U.K. 225
 - China 350
 - Pakistan 165
 - India 160
 - Israel 90
 - N. Korea 20

- 2. Jesus said...Luke 21:10-11, 28, 31, 34-36
- 3. Ezekiel's Experience: What God showed him.
 - A. Israel's backslidden condition at this time: Judah was in captivity; Jerusalem and The Temple were on the verge of being destroyed.
 - B. Ezekiel was in captivity in Babylon and God gave him a vision. **Ezk. 1:4, 26-28**
 - C. Ezekiel had another vision in which he was taken to Jerusalem and saw the sins of Israel **Ezk. 8:3-4**
 - D. The Glory of God leaving the temple and Jerusalem. Ezk. 10:3-4, 15, 18-20; Ezk. 11:1, 23-24
 - E. The promise of God's return to Jerusalem and the Temple would be back through the Eastern Gate. **Ezk. 43:1-2, 4-5**
 - F. Then the Eastern Gate would be shut until the Messiah returns. **Ezk. 44:1-3** See also, **Acts 1:9-12** and **Zech. 14:4-5**
 - G. Pictures of the Eastern Gate and The Church of all Nations.
 - 1. The Four Gospels recording of Jesus' return.
