Jesus Christ Our Shepherd

1. God's name revealed to Moses

Ex. 3:13-15 "I AM"

- 2. When Jesus came He identified Himself as The Great "I AM" in numerous ways: "I Am" (a) "The Bread of Life"; (b) "The Light of the World"; (c) "The Way, the Truth, the Life"; (d) "The Manna that came down from heaven"; (e) "The True Vine" (you are the branches) and (f) "The Door of the sheep".
- 3. He also identified Himself as...
 - A. The Shepherd of the sheep.
 - 1. "The Good Shepherd" Jn. 10:11, 14
 - 2. "The Great Shepherd" Heb. 13:20
 - B. **Psalm 23** David understood God as our Shepherd and we as His sheep.
- 4. The shepherds of Israel were prophesied against by Old Testament Prophets. **Ezek. 34:1-5**
 - A. Jesus' compassion for the people.

Matt. 9:36; Mk. 6:34

- B. Jesus as our Shepherd. Jn. 10:2-5
 - 1. **Jn. 10:16** "Other sheep I have which are not of this fold." I.E., we Gentiles
 - 2. When Jesus returns...I Peter 5:4

Psalm 23

1. Psalm 23:1

- A. "The Lord is my Shepherd" God must become very personable with each of us. "I shall not want". God will supply all our needs.
- B. **Psalm 23:2** "He maketh me to lie down in green pastures." He settles us when we are restless.
- C. "He leadeth me beside the still waters." For peace and safety for the sheep.
- D. **Psalm 23:4** "The valley of the shadow of death." Where wolves or other animals may be watching.
 - 1. **Psalm 91:5-7** "I will fear no evil for thou art with me."
 - 2. "Thy rod...and staff...comfort me. Our comfort. The Word of God and the Spirit of God.
- E. Psalm 23:5 "Thou preparest a table before me"
 - 1. "In the presence of mine enemies." (Wolves, etc.)
 - 2. "Anointest my head with oil." Keeping flies and insects away. **Il Cor. 7:1; Phil. 4:8**
 - 3. "My cup runneth over." He gives us more than enough.
