

Faith in Action

Ephesians 2:8 Romans 5:2

1. The definition of Grace: “The unearned favor of God”. Faith is our response to God’s grace.
2. Examples of grace and faith in action.
 - A. **Mk. 2:1-5, 11-12** Man sick of the palsy.
 1. Grace in action. **Mk. 1:34**
 2. Faith in action. **Mk. 2:5** (opened up the roof)
 - B. **Mk. 5:22-23** Jairus sought Jesus for the healing of his daughter – this was faith in action.
 - C. **Mk. 5:24-34** The woman with the issue of blood. Her act of faith brought her healing.
 - D. **Mk. 5:35-42** Jairus’ daughter healed. Note! Unbelief was put out of the room. Sometimes we must wait on God.
 - E. **Mk. 10:46** Blind Bartimaeus: He understood that Jesus was the Messiah. See. **I Chron. 17:11-14, 17** and **Isa. 42:1, 7, 16** and **Isa. 28:18**
3. **Heb. 11** Acts of faith in the Old Testament as examples to us. Abel (vs4), Noah (vs7), Abraham (vs8), Moses (vss24-28), the Children of Israel (vs. 30)
4. **Acts 2:37-38** Acts of faith to be saved. Repentance, Water Baptism, infilling of the Holy Ghost. See Acts 19:2-6
