The Place of His Name

- 1. **Deut. 12:11**; **Deut. 12:5-6**; **14:23**; **15:20**; **16:6** This is mentioned 17 times here in the scriptures.
- 2. God's name there represented His presence and commitment to Israel.
 - A. Ex. 3:15-17 God's name revealed to Moses.
 - B. Ex. 4:2-4, 6-7 God's commitment to Israel.
 - C. **Ex. 6:6, 8** God's commitment to bring them out of Egypt and into the Promise Land.
- 3. God's name placed in Palestine also represented His favor and abundant blessings upon Israel. **Deut. 28:8, 10, 12-13**
- 4. This "place" would eventually become Jerusalem.

 Psa. 132. 13-14; I Kg. 11:13,32 and particularly the Temple.
 - A. Ezekiel's experience: Ezk. 1:1, 4, 26-28;
 - A. Ezekiel's vision when taken in the spirit back to Jerusalem. **Ezk. 8:3,4**

 - 3. God's promise that the presence of God would return to Jerusalem. **Psa. 24:7-10**
 - 1. When it happened. Jn. 12:1, 12-16;
 - The Eastern Gate will remain shut until Jesus returns. Ezk. 44:1-3; Acts 1:9-12;
