- D. <u>The 1000 years of peace</u>. Christ shall set up this period of time on earth when he comes <u>with</u> His Church at Armegeddon.
- II. "<u>The day of the LORD</u>". This phrase is found in many places throughout the Old Testament and refers to <u>Armageddon</u> (Rev.16:16).
