 - A. God's promise to Abraham. Gen. 12:2-3 and to all Israel. Psa. 122:6
- 2. Those who <u>oppose</u> the people of God likewise will receive rejection and judgment. **Matt. 25:41-46**
- 3. Israel and example.
 - A. Jacob and Esau. Gen. 25:29-34
 - 1. Jacob received the birthright blessing from Isaac.
 - 2. Later, as nations, Esau (Edom) resisted Israel. Num. 20:14, 17-18, 21
 - B. When God judged Israel for her sins in 588B.C., Edom became Israel's bitter enemy. See the Book of Obadiah.
 Oba. 1:1, 3-4, 8-15, 18-19; Psa. 137:1-4, 7
- 4. God requires us (the church) not to be revengeful, but to be kind; even to our enemies. Rom. 12:19-21, Matt. 5:44-46; Prov. 25:21-22
- 5. In return God will fight our battles and give us lasting victory. **Heb. 10:30-31**

A. He will be kind to those who are good to us. Mark 9:41
