## The Seven Dispensations Continued Part 3

- 1. The 5<sup>th</sup> Dispensation: From Babylonian Captivity to Calvary.
  - A. God's promise of complete restoration:
    - 1. Isa. 2:1-4; 49:22; 66:20; Hos. 3:4-5 Hos. 6:1-2
    - 2. This is what Israel wanted from their Messiah.
  - B. But the Old Testament Prophets also spoke of Israel's rejection of their Messiah and His death.
    - 1. While still in Babylonian captivity, Daniel repented for all Israel. **Dan. 9:3-5**
    - 2. The Angel Gabriel appeared to him. **Dan. 9:21-22**
    - 3. Gabriel's message. Dan. 9:24-27
    - 4. Note: The coming Messiah's death. **Dan. 9:26.** See also **Isa. 53:8-9,12**
  - C. The destruction of the City of Jerusalem and the sanctuary ...again. **Dan. 9:26.** 
    - 1. Jesus knew this was coming.
      - Luke 19:41-44; 21:5-6
    - 2. **Dan. 9:26** was fulfilled in 70 A.D. when the Roman Army destroyed Jerusalem under the leadership of Titus.
    - 3. **Dan. 9:27** Happened in 135 A.D. under the leadership of Hadrian, Emperor of Rome
- 2. Israel is yet to be fully restored as God intends it to be.
