

The Sixth Dispensation Part Four

1. As a reminder: The 5th Dispensation would end with Israel's rejection of Christ (crucifixion) and the destruction of Jerusalem. **Dan. 9:26-27; Luke 21:20-24**

2. The 6th Dispensation, The Church Age, began with the Jews:
Acts 1:4-5; 12; 2:1-4; 38-39; 41
 - A. God then began to work among the Gentiles.
Acts 10:34-35, 44-48

 - B. God called Paul to be the Apostle to the Gentiles.
II Tim. 1:11; Rom. 11:13; Rom. 15:16

 - C. As the gospel spread among the Gentiles the Jews (as a nation) began more and more to reject Christianity.

 - D. But Paul reminds us that Israel, as a Nation, would be blinded "until the fulness of the Gentiles..." would be completed. **Rom. 11:25-26** see also **Luke 21:24**

3. This "Time of the Gentiles"; The Church Age; The gospel will be preached in all the world. **Mk 16:15-17; Matt. 24:14**

4. God will yet deal with Israel in these last days of the Sixth Dispensation.
See Dan. 9:27; Rev. 11:1-3; and Zech. 12:9-10
