## **Christmas One: The Birth of Christ**

- Only two of the Gospel writers in the New Testament records Jesus' birth and the surrounding events: Matthew and Luke. Each gave a somewhat different account then the other. Here is what each emphasized and why.
  - A. Luke's Gospel: He records God's way in which he used Mary to bring forth the Messiah.
    - 1. The Angel Gabriel appears to Mary. Luke 1:26-35
    - 2. Mary visits her cousin Elizabeth. Luke 1:39-42
  - B. Matthew's Gospel: He records how God spoke to Joseph and used him to protect Mary and maintain her honor. **Matt. 1:18-25** 
    - 1. **Note:** The angel always appeared to Joseph in a dream. See. **Matt. 1:20**, **Matt. 2:13**, **19**, **22**
- 2. The actual birth of Jesus.
  - A. Luke's account: Luke 2:3-7
    - 1. A very humble birth. (the poor can relate)

      Mark 12:37, 41-44,
    - 2. No room for them in the Inn.
    - 3. Shepherds in the fields nearby. Luke 2:8-17
    - 4. Jesus named and circumcised the eighth day. **Luke 2:21-22**
    - 5. Returned to Nazareth. Luke 2:39
  - B. Matthew's account: More majestic: with emphasis of Jesus as the New King.
    - 1. See Matt. 2:1-2
    - 2. Travel time from Babylon to Jerusalem was 4 months. See **Ezra 7:9**
