Why Praise Is Powerful

Luke 19:37-38 & Romans 15:9-11

- 1. The History of Praise
 - a. Praise is found twice in Genesis: Genesis 29:35 & Genesis 49:8
 - b. Praise is mentioned in only four places in all the Law Books.
 - c. The Old Testament was a covenant: an agreement. Those under the covenant benefited from the covenant. But praise is an act of appreciation and adoration to the covenant maker for the covenant.
- 2. David discovered the power in praise while discovering the wonder of God's Word.
 - a. Psalm 119:10-11, 16, 47-48, 105, 127-128, 160-161
 - b. David learned that God responds to praise. The word "praise" is found 164 times in Psalms Psalms 150
 - c. As king he made praise a prime objective. This was known as the Tabernacle of David. I Chronicles 16:4, 7-11, 23, 29, 37, 40-41
- 3. Amos 9:11 The Tabernacle of David is fallen.
- 4. Acts 15:16 I will rebuild again the Tabernacle of David. I.E. Worship with praise.
- 5. Christ never rejected praise Luke 19:37-40
 - a. It is God's will that we praise Him.
 - b. Expect some flax sometimes.
 - c. Praise God when you don't feel like it.
 - 1. Praise Him under the worse conditions Acts 16:22-25
 - 2. Praise Him loudly Psalm 100 "Make a joyful noise unto the Lord" Acts 16:25 "the prisoners heard them"
- 6. Teach your children to praise God Psalm 78:4
- 7. Praise God all your life Psalm 104:33 & Psalm 146:2
