- 1. Abraham: God's name "Elshadai" Gen. 17:1-2 "God almighty" Gen. 35:11-12
 - A. God's requirement was to believe that God could and would do what He promised. I.E. Faith was required.
- Moses and The Law: God's name was Yawah, Jehovah,
 I.E. the "I am". Ex. 3:13-15 He was the all present God.
 (To do all things He promised.)
 - A. God's requirement was for Israel to keep faith in God by obeying His commandments.
- **3.** God in the Old Testament confirmed to Israel that He, and He alone is Israel's Saviour and Redeemer.

Isa. 43:3, 10-11, 14, 15; 44:6,8,24; 45:12,18, 21-22

4. Then came Jesus:

God appeared to Joseph concerning the birth of Jesus.

Matt. 1:18-21 "...shall call His name Jesus" I.E. "Savior"

Luke 2:11 The "I am" of the Old Testament became the "I am Savior" (Jesus) in the New Testament.
