- I.
  1. Jesus's first coming was to the Jews.  
**Matt. 15:24; 10:5-6** But they rejected Him.
    - A. They knew not the day of their visitation.  
**Luke 19:41-44**
  2. After His resurrection Jesus turned to the Gentiles.  
**Matt. 28:19-20; Mark 16:15-17**
  3. Jesus spoke of the judgement that was to come on Israel.  
**Luke 21:5-6, 20-24.** This happened in 70 AD.
  4. How long will this be? **Hosea 5:15 – 6:1-2, II Peter 3:8**
  5. God's promise to revive Israel. **Jer. 30:3, 10**
- II. But in the meantime, God is raising up a Gentile Church to be His people. **Matt. 16:15-16, 18** The word church is found over 100 times in the New Testament.
  1. To the church Jesus promised to return and to give each of us an eternal glorified body.  
**John 14:2-3; Acts 1:8-11; I Thes. 4:15-18**  
We often call this 2<sup>nd</sup> coming of Christ "The Rapture".
  2. Signs of His coming. **Luke 21:25-28, 31 Matt. 24:36-42, 44**

  1. **Rev. 6:2-8** The four horses of the apocalypse.
    - A. False Peace
    - B. War
    - C. Famine
    - D. Death  $\frac{1}{4}$  world population
  2. **Rev. 6:12-17** Many disasters will come on the earth.
  3. **Rev. 9:13-15**  $\frac{1}{3}$  world population killed.
