 - A. Love God with all your heart, soul, mind. Love your neighbor (fellow man) as yourself. **vs. 40** "On these...hang all the law and prophets"
 - B. Example: The Ten Commandments: Deut. 5
 - 1. The first four. vss. 7-12: Toward God.
 - 2. The last six. vss. 16-21: Toward our fellow man.
 - 3. All the other 803 commandments in the Old Testament follow this example.
 - C. Other examples of this truth.
 - 1. Psalms The importance of our love for God.
 - a) Just a few of the many Psalms that reflect this truth.

- 2. Proverbs The importance of our love and relationship with those around us.

 - b) But life on this earth, as Solomon saw it, was futile. **Eccl. 1:1-3**

 - 2. Stony places
