

What's In Your Hand?

Exodus 4:1-2 I Samuel 17:40

1. Symbolically speaking the hands are the reflection of the heart toward others.
 - A. Examples
 - 1) Handshake – friends
 - 2) “Give us a hand” – help us
 - 3) “Wash my hands of the situation” – through with it
 - 4) The actions of the hands reveals what is in the heart.
2. Moses: **Ex. 3:17, 20; 4:1-4, 6-7, 17**
3. David: **I Sam. 17:40, 49-50**
4. Jesus feeding the multitude. **Matt. 14:15-21**
5. Peter & John entering into the Temple Courtyard. **Acts 3:1-8** The healing of the lame man.
 - A. What's in your hand?
 - 1) Are you a musician? Singer? Worshiper (with hands raised)? A greeter (handshake)? Working in the parking lot? Witnessing to new people; giving out tracts; teaching Bible Studies.
 - 2) As a child of God, What is in your hand? Your talents, your gifts and abilities to help others to come to God or grow in the grace of God.
6. How God has used people who seemed to have nothing...but God saw something...in their hand or heart...that God could use and He used them.
7. Will you let God use you to advance the Kingdom of God?
