- 1. Symbolically speaking the hands are the reflection of the heart toward others.
 - A. Examples
 - 1) Handshake friends
 - 2) "Give us a hand" help us
 - 3) "Wash my hands of the situation" through with it
 - 4) The actions of the hands reveals what is in the heart.
- 2. Moses: Ex. 3:17, 20; 4:1-4, 6-7, 17
- 3. David: I Sam. 17:40, 49-50
- 4. Jesus feeding the multitude. Matt. 14:15-21
- 5. Peter & John entering into the Temple Courtyard. **Acts 3:1-8** The healing of the lame man.
 - A. What's in your hand?
 - Are you a musician? Singer? Worshiper (with hands raised)? A greeter (handshake)? Working in the parking lot? Witnessing to new people; giving out tracts; teaching Bible Studies.
 - 2) As a child of God, What is in your hand? Your talents, your gifts and abilities to help others to come to God or grow in the grace of God.
- 6. How God has used people who seemed to have nothing...but God saw something...in their hand or heart...that God could use and He used them.
