- **Connection Groups:** Attendance divided by 2 (to remove children), then divided by 10 (# of people in a Connection Group)
- **Yearly Outreach Projects:** Total Connection Groups multiplied by 2 (2 projects per group per year)
- **Annual Giving:** Attendance divided by 2 (to remove children), then divided by 2 again (to account for married couples), multiplied by \$5,000 (10% of average household income of \$50,000)
